### Medical and Medicine

**\$100** will provide medical treatment for 28 children in need

**\$100** will provide basic medicines to treat more than 50 people

**\$250** will provide six months of vital prenatal care

**\$1,000** will provide one month's salary for six hospital staff

**\$2,500** to buy new dental equipment for one of our hospitals

**\$5,000** to purchase new equipment for one of our hospitals

### Food and Nutrition

**\$500** will provide one month of meals for in-patients

**\$1,000** provides 12,500 meals (8 cents per meal!) for starving children as a result of the drought

**\$5,000** will provide 8,000 special supplementary meals for malnourished children

### Economic Development

**\$1,500** to **\$2,500** micro-loan provides seed funding for cottage industries

### Water

**\$1,000** per month for water tanker drivers, repairs and insurance

**\$1,400** per month for fuel for water tanker and generator for one of our hospitals
